- Warm-ups before matches will be allowed on the BLUE courts on the West side of the Indoor Centre, or on our Astroturf if it is not being used.
- Change rooms and bathrooms will be open subject to cleaning.
- The Pool will be open at your own risk.
- Please don't litter.
- Strict hygiene practices will be expected from all players/spectators/coaches/staff/guests.
- The Hockey Farm is proudly a family friendly environment. We thus have a strict "no tolerance" anti-social and inappropriate behaviour. We will have anyone violating these policies removed from the facility.
- Alcohol can be purchased at the Venue. Alcohol CAN NOT BE BROUGHT ONTO THE PREMISIS.
